Position Summary

The Research Assistant is responsible for assisting the Breeder and Trial Manager with all research operations at WinGen's facility in Mustang Ridge, Texas.

Primary areas of responsibility:

- Assist the breeder to ensure all research and breeding related tasks are completed on schedule and to the highest standards
- Oversee health of all plants within R&D program

Key Responsibilities

Research and Development tasks

- Organize, lead and carry out all aspects of pollinations, seed collections and sowings, plant transplanting, plant selections, virus testings, and vegetative harvests
- Investigate and carry out breeding research experiments
- Collection of trial data
- Supervise and instruct a crew of 1-5 people at a time as needed.
- Assist with other tasks as needed.

Position Requirements

- Bachelor of Science degree in Horticulture, Agriculture or related field OR 3-5 years' experience working in a horticultural research setting preferred
- Employee will work in accordance with WinGen LLC's employee code of conduct and employment policies. Job is located at WinGen's Mustang Ridge, TX facility and the employee must provide their own transportation.
- The employee must be authorized to work in the United States and will always maintain this eligibility.
